**PROCEDURAL ORDER**


On April 14, 2017, plaintiffs filed a Master Long Form Complaint (“Master Complaint”) (doc. no. [53](#)). On June 5, 2017, plaintiffs filed a notice of a proposed Short Form Complaint (doc. no. [71](#)), to which they attached as an exhibit the Short Form Complaint (doc. no. [71-1](#)). On June 6, 2017, defendants filed their Master Answers to the Master Complaint (doc. nos. [74](#), [75](#), and [77](#)).

Pursuant to paragraph 4.3 of Case Management Order No. 3 (doc. no. [39](#)), the court hereby approves the Master Complaint. Plaintiffs shall refile the Short Form Complaint (doc. no. [71-1](#)) as a stand-alone document.

Under paragraph 4.4 of Case Management Order No. 3, individual plaintiffs who have previously filed complaints in this MDL shall file a Short Form Complaint on or before August 11, 2017 (60 days from the date of this order approving the Master Complaint). Individual plaintiffs shall file the Short Form Complaint in each plaintiff’s underlying civil case, not in the master case docket number 16-md-2753-LM. Within 21 days after receipt of the Short Form Complaint, defendants shall file an entry of appearance, which acknowledges receipt of the Short Form Complaint, in each plaintiff’s underlying civil case. Defendants shall not file such entries of appearance in the master case docket number 16-md-2753-LM.

To initiate a new case in this district that is related to the MDL, a plaintiff shall open a new civil case and file the Short Form Complaint in that case, not in the master case docket number 16-md-2753-LM. Within 21 days after receipt of the Short Form Complaint, defendants shall file an entry of appearance, which acknowledges receipt of the Short Form Complaint, in each plaintiff's underlying civil case. Defendants shall not file such entries of appearance in the master case docket number 16-md-2753-LM.
