**CASE MANAGEMENT ORDER NO. 3E(i)
ADDENDUM TO PROTECTIVE ORDER**

Pursuant to ¶ 7(b)(8) of the Protective Order, Case Management Order No. 3E, plaintiffs' treating physicians are allowed to review documents that have been designated CONFIDENTIAL – SUBJECT TO PROTECTIVE ORDER subject to the following conditions:

At least two weeks prior to a treating physician's deposition, plaintiff must provide defendants with a) the identity of all documents marked as CONFIDENTIAL – SUBJECT TO PROTECTIVE ORDER provided to the treating physician during any *ex parte* communications, b) the date of the *ex parte* communications with the treating physicians, and c) the duration of and participants in the *ex parte* communications. As set forth in ¶ 7(b)(8) of the Protective Order, any treating physician who reviews documents that have been designated CONFIDENTIAL – SUBJECT TO PROTECTIVE ORDER shall execute the certification contained in Attachment A, to the Protective Order, Acknowledgement of Understanding and Agreement to Be Bound.
