<u>ORDER</u>

Effective November 3, 2014, the United States Probation Office will commence filing proposed Sentencing Options and Supervision Conditions in all criminal cases scheduled for sentencing. Pending amendment of L.R. 32.1, the following deadlines shall apply:

- (1) The probation officer shall file proposed Sentencing Options and Supervision Conditions no later than fourteen (14) days prior to the scheduled sentencing date.
- (2) Any party objecting to the proposed Sentencing Options and Supervision Conditions must include those objections in the sentencing memorandum due no later than ten (10) days before the date of the scheduled sentencing hearing.
- (3) On the date of the sentencing hearing, the defendant shall execute and file an acknowledgement confirming s/he received, reviewed and understood the proposed Sentencing Options and Supervision Conditions.
