I COMMAND THE JUDGMENT CREDITOR, or their counsel, to accompany the United States Marshal should it be necessary during the execution of this writ, to answer any questions that may arise during execution, and, unless otherwise ordered by the court, to serve as the substitute custodian over and maintain direct responsibility for the custody of any property levied upon by the United States Marshal. A substitute custodian shall hold the United States Marshal harmless for any damage to the seized property while in their custody.

I FURTHER COMMAND THE JUDGMENT CREDITOR to compensate the United States Marshal for fees and expenses incurred during the execution of this writ to the extent not satisfied through the levy process.
