
ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

The United States Marshal, with the approval of the Court Security Committee for the District of New Hampshire, will require visitors to present identification prior to being allowed to enter the Rudman Courthouse and Cleveland Federal Building. The United States Marshal shall determine the forms of identification that are acceptable for admission. Bar Cards may substitute for this identification requirement.

The United States Marshal, or a designee, may for good cause shown approve access to any visitor who does not have an acceptable form of identification and may require that individual to record his or her name in a log maintained by Court Security Officers.
