ADM 1 ORDER 25-9

Effective Monday, October 20, 2025, the United States District Court for the District of New Hampshire will no longer have sufficient funding to sustain full, paid operations due to the ongoing lapse in congressional appropriations.

During this period, the Court will maintain only those operations necessary to carry out its constitutional and statutory duties. While certain functions will continue, members of the public, the bar, and litigants may experience reduced operations, limited staffing, and potential delays in some services.

The Case Management/Electronic Case Files (CM/ECF) system will remain in operation for electronic filing, the Clerk's Office will remain open for receipt of paper filings, and criminal and civil cases will proceed in the normal course (e.g. hearings and deadlines will remain as scheduled unless the parties are otherwise notified). The Court will provide updates as additional information becomes available or as circumstances change.

This order shall be immediately vacated upon the approval of an appropriation by the other branches of government and may be superseded or amended by further order of the court.
