US v. Zimny

Criminal Law & Procedure

(United States First Circuit) - Convictions of wire fraud, engaging in unlawful monetary transactions, filing false tax returns, and bank fraud are remanded with instructions that the district court conduct an investigation into the juror-misconduct allegations raised in the additional-juror comment, where the district court's inquiry into defendant's claims of juror misconduct was inadequate.

US v. Martinez-Armestica

Criminal Law & Procedure, Sentencing

(United States First Circuit) - Sentence and conviction of carjacking, using, carrying, and brandishing a firearm during a crime of violence, and four counts of illegal possession of firearms seen in photographs on defendant's cell phone, are affirmed over defendant's arguments that: 1) there was insufficient evidence for the jury to find that he brandished a real gun during the carjacking; 2) the trial judge erred in admitting testimony from the government's firearms expert related to the illegal possession counts; and 3) his sentence was unreasonable.
