Angiodynamics, Inc. v. Biolitec, Inc.

January 23, 2018

Civil Procedure, Debt Collection

(United States First Circuit) - Affirming lower court judgments in a case that clearly frustrated the court and the plaintiffs involving a company's many procedural attempts to avoid satisfying a twenty three million dollar judgment against them because the court turned a deaf ear to their arguments attempting to avoid contempt orders previously entered against them, determining that they had waived critical arguments and holding that the district court's denial of motions for relief were not an abuse of discretion.

Cranston Firefighters v. Raimondo

Civil Procedure, Constitutional Law, Contracts

(United States First Circuit) - Affirming the district court dismissal of a complaint alleging that Rhode Island changes to firefighter and police officer pension plans was an unconstitutional repudiation of contractual obligations because the complaint failed to allege that the challenged legislation unconstitutionally impaired any contractual rights and finding that federal court was not the proper forum to litigate undeveloped claims or to challenge the terms of a settlement by other parties in another lawsuit.

Kando v. Rhode Island State Board of Elections

Civil Procedure, Labor & Employment Law, Constitutional Law

(United States First Circuit) - Affirming the grant of a motion for judgment on the pleadings by the Rhode Island State Board of Elections in a suit by a former employee alleging a violation of his constitutional rights when his employment was terminated because the plaintiff failed to establish the deprivation of a constitutionally protected interest.
