NEW COURTROOM TECHNOLOGY BROWN BAG TRAININGS

The court has begun the process of upgrading the technology in the courtrooms to be compatible with current technologies and equipment (such as HDMI and wireless devices). These upgrades will improve the quality of video/document presentations as well as the courtroom audio system. The primary benefits to attorneys are:

- *Courtrooms will be cross-platform ready (Microsoft Windows and Apple);
- *Higher quality video and document evidence presentation in courtrooms via high-definition monitors (in the jury box, gallery, and behind the witness stand);
- *Improved high-definition document camera;
- *Input touchpad screens that allow attorneys to control whether to project from their laptop, wireless device, or the document camera;
- *Upgraded annotation monitors at the attorney podium and witness stand;
- *Wireless access for tablets (although cabling is available); and
- *Improved audio and videoconferencing systems.

This technology will be available in both courtrooms 4 and 5 by early February and we expect to complete the upgrades in courtrooms 1 and 2 in the summer or fall of 2015.

The court will be hosting brown bag lunches at which presenters will demonstrate the new technology and highlight some recommended best practices. At the conclusion of the presentation, attendees will be allowed to test the new system using their own laptops or tablets. The brown bag trainings will be at noon on the following dates:
