## RULES & PROCEDURES FOR FILING PRO HAC VICE MOTIONS

## PRO HAC VICE MOTIONS AT CASE OPENING

Pro hac vice motions may be filed electronically using the *Motion/Appear Pro Hac Vice* event after filing the complaint or other case initiating document, or filed conventionally in paper with a check or money order with the appropriate filing fee.

## PRO HAC VICE MOTIONS REQUESTING ADMISSION OF MULTIPLE ATTORNEYS

Due to the limitations of the CM/ECF internet credit card payment system, the Supplemental Rules for ECF require a separate motion for each attorney whose admission is sought pro hac vice and prohibit requesting pro hac vice admission of multiple attorneys in one motion. AP 3.7. Thus, if local counsel wants to request the pro hac vice admission of five attorneys, local counsel would need to electronically file five separate motions, with the appropriate supporting affidavit, for each pro hac vice attorney. See LR 83.2(b)(1). The "Appear Pro Hac Vice" motion event has been modified to include the following reminder:

NOTE: Due to limitations of the credit card payment system, you must now file a separate motion for each attorney for whom you seek pro hac vice admission. Thus, you may not request pro hac vice admission of multiple attorneys in one motion.
